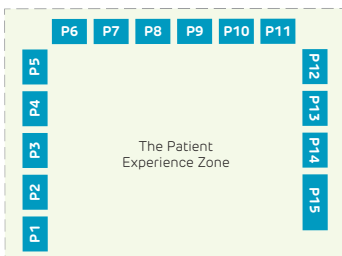


Patient Experience Zone
